He went on to train in **Jazz Performance and Arranging** at Toronto’s *Humber College*, under the guidance of such luminaries as Pat LaBarbera (Buddy Rich), Ron Collier (Duke Ellington) and CBC lead trumpet, Don Johnson.

**I**n his more than **20 years** as a music industry professional Daniel has embraced a variety of roles: from **composer** to **arranger, orchestrator** to **sound designer, and multi-instrumentalist**, he wears many hats in the studio.
